NEADS/Dogs for Deaf & Disabled Americans

For more than three decades, President Don Irving and his wife Karen have been loyal supporters of this non-profit organization. In fact, the family is so involved that their shepherd-collie mix became one of the first NEADS-trained dogs to work with a local resident who was hearing impaired.

For nearly 40 years, NEADS has been providing independence to those who are deaf or have a disability through the use of trained canines. The organization trains assorted breeds to work with individuals who have a range of physical disabilities, diseases and conditions. Matched for personality, lifestyle and need, the team of dog and human form an enduring emotional and functional bond.

In the last 30+ years, the Irvings have "named" six dogs and contributed countless volunteer hours to the organization. "We are drawn to NEADS because it is a local organization that has dramatic impact on the lives of people with disabilities," says Don Irving.

Karen Irving began volunteering for NEADS in 2003, working first in the puppy house and assisting trainers. She recently became a member of NEADS' board of directors and remains dedicated to helping the organization adhere to its mission. "This is something I believe in," she says.

Most recently, a growing need among military personnel prompted the creation of Canines for Combat Veterans, a program that provides assistance dogs to wounded veterans returning from Iraq and Afghanistan. Don Irving says, "The Canine for Combat Veterans program has filled a tremendous need for our wounded veterans who are re-entering civilian life."
